


# FREEDOM BY FAITH

A STUDY OF GALATIANS




**Paul's gospel of salvation

## **Galatians 1:11**


**<sup>11</sup>For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. <sup>12</sup>For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.**

**<sup>13</sup>For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it. <sup>14</sup>And I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers. <sup>15</sup>But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, <sup>16</sup>was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone; <sup>17</sup>nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into Arabia, and returned again to Damascus.**



**Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.**

**18**Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas and remained with him fifteen days.


**19**But I saw none of the other apostles except James the Lord's brother. **20**(In what I am writing

to you, before God, I do not lie!) **21**Then I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia. **22**And I was

still unknown in person to the churches of Judea that are in Christ. **23**They only were hearing it

said, "He who used to persecute us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy."
