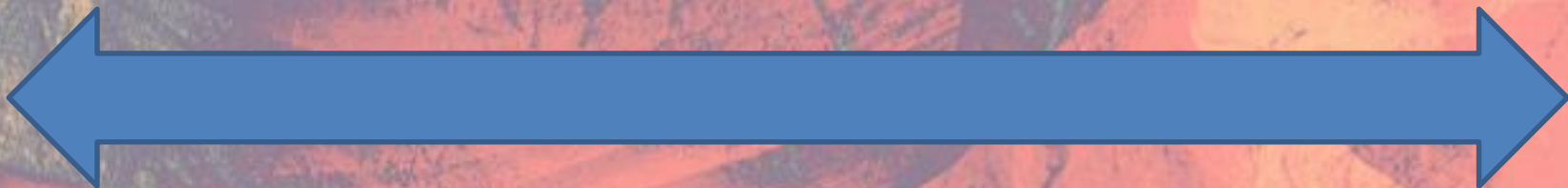




Shall not Covet (Commandment #10)
