Warning of Unbelief

Hebrews 3:7

⁷Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says,

“Today, if you hear his voice,

**⁸do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion,
on the day of testing in the wilderness,**

**⁹where your fathers put me to the test
and saw my works for forty years.**

**¹⁰Therefore I was provoked with that generation,
and said, ‘They always go astray in their heart;
they have not known my ways.’**

**¹¹As I swore in my wrath,
‘They shall not enter my rest.’”**

**¹²Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. ¹³But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called “today,” that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. ¹⁴For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. ¹⁵As it is said,
“Today, if you hear his voice,
do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.”**

**A faith that fizzles before the finish,
was faulty from the first.**

16For who were those who heard and yet rebelled? Was it not all those who left Egypt led by Moses? **17**And with whom was he provoked for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? **18**And to whom did he swear that they would not enter his rest, but to those who were disobedient? **19**So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief.
